Friendly Reminders:

- **Do not ride on the blacktop portion of Old 131 Trail.**
There is a grassy or gravel side designed for equestrian use. Use it please.
- **Expect an increase in trail users - bikes, hikers, horses.**
Make sure your mount is steady and ready to be on trails with others.
- **The Visitor Center is OPEN.**
Permits are available for purchase online (keep your receipt and confirmation number as proof of permit purchase), at self-pay stations throughout the property, or at the KVR Visitor Center.
- **Maps are available in the Iron Rangers and at the Visitor Center. Surfaces are not disinfected.**
- **Trails close in wet weather, check trail status before visiting.**
