

# Kickapoo Valley Reserve

## COVID-19 Policies in effect until further notice

- \* All campsites are **OPEN** for camping. Sites are first come, first served (no reservations). Use Iron Rangers/Self-pay station(s) for camping payment.
- \* KVR Trails are **OPEN** to hiking. Trails remain OPEN during wet conditions.
- \* Natural surface trails **CLOSED** to horse and bike\* for the season. Open May 1st - weather permitting. \*Fat-tire biking allowed in winter when conditions allow.

- \* **Horseback riders:** Trails CLOSE during wet conditions. Hay Valley Trail from Dutch Hollow Trail to Intersection 10/Bailout Trail is CLOSED due to flood damaged bridge.
- \* **Bicyclists:** Trails CLOSE during wet conditions. Yield to horses.
- \* Hunting and fishing allowed in compliance with DNR seasons and licensing.
- \* Visitor Center is **CLOSED** to the public.
- \* Outdoor restrooms @ Visitor Center are **OPEN**.
- \* Stay 6 feet apart.
- \* If there are several cars in one place, have a plan B.
- \* Man-made surfaces (tables/gates) not disinfected.
- \* Keep vehicles on solid surfaces in designated areas.
- \* ALL dogs on leash at ALL times.
- \* Do not leave human/pet waste above ground. Dig cat holes and cover waste at least 200 ft from campsites, water sources and trails. Bag and remove pet waste or bury.
- \* Take ALL trash and belongings with you. Do not dispose of trash or food items in the firepit.
- \* Call 911 for all Emergencies.
- \* Check KVR Website or Facebook Page for updates.
- \* Policies subject to change if violations or Federal/State directives require!
