


Kickapoo Valley Dark Sky Park



The Kickapoo Valley Dark Sky Park is a cooperative initiative by Wildcat Mountain State Park, Kickapoo Valley Reserve, and Mississippi Valley Conservancy to conserve and share the starry skies above 13,330 acres along the Kickapoo River in eastern Vernon County in the Driftless Area of southwest Wisconsin.
