Campsite Description: Willow Camp is a popular campsite for equestrian use. It is easily accessible for larger rigs and boasts beautiful vistas of the valley. Willow Camp is a multiple unit site, meaning there are 4 designated sites that each hold ten people in the same 4 acre area. Each campsite (D1, D2, D3, D4) is required to pay the \$15 per night camping fee. There is no permanent water at Willow Camp. Plan to haul and store water. Water is also available at the Visitor Center. There is intermittent shade at this campsite. Campsite D is designated for self contained units only plus one tent limit per site. Self-contained unit must accompany tent.
