

## Campsite J Mule Camp

**Location:** Hwy 131 2 miles N of KVR Visitors Center on the left or just south of County Hwy P intersection. Gravel drive west to campsite.

**Type:** Vehicle Accessible

**Camping Fee:** \$15 per night per 10 people

**Capacity:** 20 people

**Amenities:** Fire Pit, Tie lines

**Traffic Level:** Secluded

**Trail Access:** Mule Trail at site

**River Access:** None

**Nearest River Access:** 2 highway miles to Landing 14

**Nearest Registration:** At site near Hwy 131 or Visitors Center

**Water:** Summer Water Buffalo at Willow Camp

**Potable Water:** Water Buffalo at Willow Camp in summer months or KVR Visitors Center

**Flowing Water:** Small spring at the bottom of Mule Trail at Old Hwy 131 Trail

**Campsite Description:** Mule Camp is a picturesque campsite with open space for grazing your stock and a set of shade trees to provide protection from the sun. This is for a single group only. Mule Camp has easy access and a large area for larger rigs to maneuver.
